- Last date of abstract submission is 30th September 2025.

GUIDELINES FOR ORAI/POSTER PRESENTATION

- Poster should be printed on flex of size: 36 inches width
 x 48 inches height.
- Un-crowded diagrams and tables should be included.
- Font: Times New Roman/Tahoma.
- Text should be visible from the distance of 3 meters.
- Adhere to a simple colour palette to ensure visibility of text against an appropriate background.
- Time allotted: 8 minutes for presentation and 2 minutes for questions.
- For oral presentation, should have 8 power point slides.
